## Facts & FIGURES

"We must never forget that the church is the expression of God's Kingdom to the lost world. The church is the instrument through which God desires Christians to carry out the Great Commission. Therefore, schools must relate closely to the church...*church* has become narrowly defined as those activities that take place on Sunday, Wednesday night, and during special events scheduled periodically throughout the year. When churches do not *expand their ministries* to include the weekday education ministry (regardless of grade or age level) and only attach a school to the *church*, there will always be competition and conflict between the two entities. When a church expands its ministry to include weekday education (a Christian School), it must develop a consistent theology of ministry for the entire church. This will mean that the families ministered to by the school are as much a part of the church as those ministered to in a Sunday morning worship service. There is a strong tendency to deal with the school ministry in a totally different way than another Sunday ministry is treated."
