What are those categories in the bulletin? Each week, you see a financial report noting how much was given to each category. Here is how we define them:

- General Fund** - The general operating expenses for the ministry as a whole.
- Faith Promise Missions** - Believers who understand both the individual and corporate burden for global outreach commit to giving to missions. Sometimes, this giving is sacrificial - meaning you will forego something or trust God to provide. It can also be choosing to give because you recognize God has abundantly provided for you.
- Debt Retirement** - Consistent contributions to the Building Fund enabled us to expand our facility with little debt. We took out a \$500,000 loan to build the Activity Building. The "debt retirement" is an effort to pay off the loan before the balloon payment is due.
- Endowment Fund** - Tuition does not allow us to adequately pay our teaching staff. The long-term goal is to build the fund from which we perpetually draw interest to supplement salaries. Right now, we get about \$1,500 per year.
- KCA gifts** - The Academy is a ministry to families and involves many people. You can encourage people or programs by donating to the Academy.
