The **Christian Education Vision Endowment of Berryville, VA**, is a fund established in 2009 to raise teacher salaries at Keystone Christian Academy. The objective of an endowment is to build a principal and use the interest. Ideally, the base amount will grow to the point that the yearly interest will make a significant difference. As of January 16, 2026, the endowment fund was \$75,032, and the check to the school this year was \$3,500. According to our annual statement, "The endowment enjoyed a return on investment of over 9.7%. Next year's distribution will be 5% of the 2025 year-end Vision Endowment Balance." This goes toward the increase in salaries for this school year. Our endowment fund receives small gifts from our church family each week, but the intent is to allow individuals to give larger amounts - usually through estate planning (wills, bequests, etc.). Every person, Christians especially, should have a will! You can continue stewarding your resources even when you leave this earth. Otherwise, the state will do it for you, and its interests are not guided by eternal values. Lord willing, you can leave funds that will make a difference long after you are gone. If you need recommendations for estate planning or a will, we can provide them.
