Facts & FIGURES

The **Growth Classes** are what most people think of as Sunday School. They are designed for interaction and to cover practical information. One of the things I (Pastor Wright) am concerned about is that COVID changed our schedule and our thinking. People are less committed to attending regularly and will allow things to interfere with their commitment to their church family. The result is that people are not learning the Bible as well. Eventually, that will lead to a less literate congregation and make them susceptible to theological dangers. We changed our Sunday night schedule because we determined it best fit our church family. Years ago, we had moved our prayer time to Sunday night (rather than Wednesday). When we changed the Sunday night schedule, we moved the prayer time to 9:00 AM. The prayer time is a sweet and valuable time. As noted in the passage we studied last Sunday, prayer is essential for resisting temptation. It empowers believers - not just the act of prayer, but dependence on the God to whom we pray. So, prayer and biblical literacy must be a priority! Do your best to be part of both the 9 AM prayer and the 9:30 Growth Classes.
