Facts & FIGURES

The **9:30 AM Growth Classes** are "age graded." That means we are putting people of the same general age in classes together. While the actual ages can vary significantly, we are structuring it around those with children at home and those without. For the adults who are not in choir, we have a "Nesters" and "Empty Nesters" class. In other words, you either have children still in the home or you do not. Ideally we would like to see each class bond and grow. With growth should come division. Not divisiveness, but dividing the class. Once a class reaches 15-18 people, we would like to begin a new class. Perhaps in the empty-nest class, we would separate those who still go to their place of employment each day from those who make their own schedule. Again, the goal is to have a place where people can identify with others, build friendships, but most of all, grow in the Lord. For that to happen, we need people who adopt this as their ministry. Classes need teachers, but also peoples to contact others who could and should be in class, or to organize activities for the class. Lots of possibilities exist, but it takes someone with both an idea and initiative. If that is you, talk to your teacher or Pastor Wright.
