Facts & FIGURES

You are well aware of the changes in Virginia's leadership. The legislative session is in progress and scheduled to end on March 25. Numerous events have occurred that cause believers consternation. Among them are the proposed constitutional amendments. Later in the year, Virginians will grapple with:

- Restoring voting rights to convicted felons
- Codifying the right to abortion, contraception, and reproductive care
- Removing language that defines marriage
- And "right-to-work" protections

One amendment has been fast-tracked and is scheduled for a vote on April 21. According to the elections.virginia.gov site, it says,

- **Question:** Should the Constitution of Virginia be amended to allow the General Assembly to temporarily adopt new congressional districts to restore fairness in the upcoming elections, while ensuring Virginia's standard redistricting process resumes for all future redistricting after the 2030 census?
- Individuals who keep up with the news will chuckle at the phrase, "restore fairness." Well-informed people will remember that a plan is already in place to take partisanship out of districting. We will be happy to recommend resources to help you further understand the issue.
