- As you can tell from the chairs in the sanctuary, we are in the process of making some updates in this part of the building. Over the next couple of weeks, we are doing some work in this room. On a couple of those Sundays, we will need to meet in the Activity Building. We will publicize the schedule and meeting places weekly.
- Today is the final message in the "Gethsemane to Glory" series. Next week, we will return to our exposition of I Peter. Before Christmas of 2025, we paused our study after the first four verses of I Peter 5. Next week, we will pick up where we left off.

- We only have four children's and teen cub meetings left for this school year. The final club meetings are on May 13. After that, a schedule change causes us to miss one mid-week service, and then we will begin our Summer Kids Club.

  - \* If you would like to become a member, you must be saved, baptized by immersion, read and agree with the church constitution, and meet with Pastor Wright. If you have completed that process or would like to, we invite you to come up at the end of the service next week for the formal process.
  - \* We plan to have a baptism on the first Sunday after the sanctuary renovations are complete. Currently, that looks like it will be May 24, but that is Memorial Day weekend. We will have a baptism either that week or on May 31. If you would like to be baptized, see Pastor Wright.
- **Academy Notes:**
  - \* Last week, approximately 1,900 students from 186 schools in 33 states competed in the 48th Annual AACPS National Competition. Contestants compete in 80 categories, submitting 1,171 entries in the basic areas of Bible, music, speech, art, and academics. Our Academy had five entries. The closing program takes place after the bulletin is printed, so we will let you know how we did.
