## Facts & FIGURES

One of the difficulties we regularly address is keeping the foyer and hallways clear during the services. We have people assigned to "hall duty." There are also specific people on the security team assigned to different parts of the building. If you are not on hall duty or assigned to a specific ministry during the service, you need to be in the service or classes. People are not to "hang out" in the foyer, offices, or other parts of the building. Not being in the services undermines one of the church's primary aspects- teaching and learning. This applies to you! Each person who excuses his presence outside the service or classroom influences others to do the same. We must exercise leadership and help people move toward the scheduled activities. In addition, please do your best not to leave during the service, but if you must, when you return, wait for a break (not during solos or prepared music) and either return to your seat or take a seat in the back. As a church family, we must work hard to have as many of our church family members as possible in the service and to reduce distractions as much as possible. Accomplishing this will require a unified effort.
