You know which houses have children, so it is more effective to target those households. Remember, one of principles of **G.R.O.W.** is sowing and reaping. You cannot reap when you do not sow. That means our teams have sown over 300 seeds. The flyer is a tool the Lord can use to prompt a family to visit where they can hear the gospel. In addition, it is well established that the Lord often brings people (other than those we contacted) because we put forth effort. God honors your effort to glorify Him. **G.R.O.W.** is built on our responsibility to be ambassadors. The program is designed to give you an avenue to fulfill your responsibility.
