Facts & FIGURES

Today, at the beginning of our service, we have our church business meeting to approve our budget. Below are a few notes to remind us of our procedures.

1. Our deacons and trustees have a monthly meeting on the schedule and review the finances. That review includes the balances in our accounts and, when available, a monthly financial statement. We have guidelines in our constitution that require major expenses to be brought before the congregation. Otherwise, we operate within the budget and with the approval of the deacons and trustees.
2. We have a financial secretary who pays the bills, keeps records, and prepares financial statements. Those statements are reviewed by the pastor, treasurer, and the deacons and trustees.
3. Our philosophy is to avoid debt. In the time Pastor Wright has been here, we have only borrowed money once. That was after we had set aside several hundred thousand dollars for the first phase. We borrowed \$500,000 to complete the project. Our church family has paid the rest as we built. The total is between \$1.5 and \$2 million. The current loan is below \$130,000, and the goal is to pay it off in the next two years.
