Facts & FIGURES

Last Sunday, we approved our budget for the coming year. Overall, giving was down in the last fiscal year, but we know the reason and believe it will correct itself. God has been kind to our church. That kindness is in part because His people take stewardship seriously. Stewardship means that the believer recognizes that he is not the owner of anything. God is, but He entrusts things to us with instructions about how to use them. Owners take care of their stewards – especially one who faithfully fulfills his duties. Faithful stewardship means the steward asks, "What would the owner want me to do?" When one asks that question, it is clear that God uses the tithe (10%) as the starting point for giving. When you hear that and say, it seems like a lot of "your" money, you have revealed flawed thinking. It is God's money. He wants His money and possessions used for His work. That means even the possessions (whether monetary or physical) you keep should be used to glorify Him. God's kindness is abundant. Start living in obedience to Him, and you might be pleasantly surprised at the testimony you will give down the road.
