Facts & FIGURES

We say each year that "*We have exactly the students and staff the Lord wants us to have.*" Again this year, I can say that we have a great staff. They step up each year and give our students a first-class Christian education. One of the most exciting things coming down the road is the **Education Freedom Tax Credit**. This credit is a federal program established under the Working Families Tax Cuts Act. Donors in any state can claim the credit, but the state's governor must opt in for families to receive the benefit. Before Governor Youngkin left office, he opted Virginia in. While the credit does not begin until 2027, we must begin preparations now. It could allow us to reward our teaching staff more in line with what they deserve. To do that, we have to revise our tuition in a way that includes scholarship opportunities. So, rather than giving a discount to a second or third student in the same family, we can offer scholarships. The outflow of money is the same for the families, but it helps us in multiple ways, and the benefit goes to our teaching staff. On Wednesday & Thursday, August 5 (6:15 PM) & 6 (6:00 PM), we have a meeting for parents. The meeting will address both the **WV HOPE** Scholarship and the **EFTC**.
