## Facts & FIGURES

We had good meetings this week with our Academy family about the **Education Freedom Tax Credit** and the **Hope** Scholarship. This EFTC is a federal program established under the Working Families Tax Cuts Act. Lord willing, our families can benefit from the scholarship in the 2<sup>nd</sup> half of this school year or, more likely, in the 27-28 school year. In the meantime, it is important to let our friends and families know how the scholarship functions. Any person who pays federal taxes can donate \$1,700 to an SGO (Scholarship Granting Organization). Don't confuse your refund with what you owe. Your refund is generally the excess you paid. So, you paid taxes but overpaid and get some back. Here is part of an answer in the Q & A section of [accordkids.org](http://accordkids.org) – "What matters for the EFTC is your total federal income tax owed before those payments. For example, if your tax bill is \$2,000 but you had \$2,500 withheld — giving you a \$500 refund — you still have \$2,000 in tax liability that the EFTC can offset. In that case, a \$1,700 donation would generate a \$1,700 EFTC, reducing your tax liability from \$2,000 to \$300 and increasing your refund from \$500 to \$2,200. The credit works against your tax liability, not your withholding — so being on track for a refund does not disqualify you."
